ORDINANCE NO. 13 -2018

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING INDIANA DEPARTMENT
OF CORRECTION GRANT PROGRAM FUNDS

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Clark County, Indiana (the "Board"), is the executive body of Clark County government pursuant to the provisions of Ind. Code § 36-2-2-2; and,

WHEREAS, the Board is also the legislative body of Clark County government pursuant to the provisions of Ind. Code § 36-1-2-9; and

WHEREAS, Clark County has applied for and been awarded a Grant from the Indiana Department of Corrections for certain programs for Fiscal Year 2018-2019; and

WHEREAS, as a requirement of the said grant programs, local non-reverting funds for the purpose of receipting, holding and expending allowable grant program receipts and expenses must be established; and

WHEREAS, the Board now desires to establish the following four (4) Grant Program Funds.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE CLARK COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, AS FOLLOWS:

1. Establishment: The Board hereby establishes the following local non-reverting funds to be administered and maintained by the Clark County Auditor:

(a) Public Defender Court Recidivism Reduction #1	9144
(b) Public Defender Court Recidivism Reduction #2	9145
(c) Jail Treatment Services #1	9146
(d) Jail Treatment Services #2	9147

2. Deposits into the Fund: Only monies designated for the Indiana Department of Correction Grant Programs shall be deposited into the Funds.

3. Purposes of Permitted Expenditures from the Fund: Money in the Funds shall be used only to pay those expenses allowed pursuant to the Indiana Department of Correction Grant Programs.

4. Term of Fund: The term of existence of the Fund shall be perpetual until the Funds are fully expended or terminated by subsequent ordinance adopted by this Board.

5. Auditor's Duty to Manage the Fund: The Clark County Auditor is hereby directed to maintain and manage accurate accounting information regarding the receipts, expenditures, and balances of the Funds as well as any reporting requirements pursuant to Indiana law.

6. Effective Date: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage and promulgation as evidenced by the affirmative signatures of the undersigned as the majority of the duly elected and serving members of this Board.


