ORDINANCE NO. 21 -2015

**AN ORDINANCE DESIGNATING STOP INTERSECTIONS AT ST. JOHN ROAD AND
STAR HILL ROAD ENTRANCES**

WHEREAS, this Board of Commissioners of Clark County, Indiana (this "Board"), is the executive body of Clark County government pursuant to the provisions of Ind. Code § 36-2-2-2; and,

WHEREAS, this Board is also the legislative body of Clark County government pursuant to the provisions of Ind. Code 36-1-2-9; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to IC 9-21-1-3, a local authority, with respect to private roads and highways under the authority's jurisdiction may designate an intersection as a stop intersection at one (1) or more entrances to the intersection ; and

WHEREAS, St. John Road and Star Hill Road in Wood Township, Clark County, Indiana is under this Board's jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS, this Board, upon the recommendation from the Clark County Sheriff's Department, desires to add two stop signs at the three way intersection of St. John Road and Star Hill Road.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by this Board of Clark County Commissioners as follows:

1. That one stop sign shall be placed at the North bound intersection of Star Hill Road and St. John Road on Star Hill road.
2. That a second stop sign shall be placed at the East bound intersection of St. John Road and Star Hill Road on St. John Road.

3. The county engineer is hereby ordered to post the necessary signs in accordance with Indiana law and specifications notifying drivers of such change.

4. The traffic regulation shall become effective when the stop signs giving notice of the duty to stop before proceeding have been posted.

5. The Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage and promulgation as evidenced by the affirmative signatures of the undersigned as the majority of the duly elected and serving members of this Board.
