## ORDINANCE NO. <u>28 - 2012</u>

# AN ORDINANCE RE-ESTABLISHING THE CLARK COUNTY CUMULATIVE BRIDGE FUND AND IMPOSING A PROPERTY TAX RATE FOR SUCH FUND, SUBJECT TO HEARING AND APPROVAL BY THE DEPARTMENT OF LOCAL GOVERNMENT FINANCE

WHEREAS, this Board of Commissioners of Clark County, Indiana (this "Board"), is the county executive body pursuant to the provisions of IND. CODE § 36-2-2-2; and,

WHEREAS, IND. CODE § 8-16-3, et seq., and IND. CODE § 6-1.1-41, et seq., authorize this Board to establish and/or re-establish a cumulative bridge fund for purposes of constructing, maintaining, or repairing bridges, approaches, or grade separations; and,

WHEREAS, there are presently some 130 bridges in Clark County over which this Board has maintenance responsibility;

WHEREAS, prior to adoption of this Resolution, this Board held a public hearing on a proposal to re-establish a cumulative bridge fund and impose a property tax rate for such fund during a special meeting held on July 25, 2012, notice of which hearing was published in accordance with the provisions of IND. CODE § 5-3-1-2(f) in the form attached hereto as Exhibit "A" as evidenced by the proof of publication attached hereto as Exhibit "B"; and,

WHEREAS, having heard the testimony of all interested persons appearing at the public hearing, this Board now finds that it is in the best interest of the citizens of Clark County, Indiana, to re-establish the *Clark County Cumulative Bridge Fund* and levy a property tax for such fund, subject to approval by the Indiana Department of Local Government Finance (the "DLGF"), pursuant to the terms and conditions of this Ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by this Board of Clark County Commissioners as follows:

- 1. The Clark County Cumulative Bridge Fund is hereby re-established pursuant to the provisions of IND. CODE § 8-16-3, et seq., and IND. CODE § 6-1.1-41, et seq.
- 2. Subject to approval by the department of the DLGF, a tax at a rate of Five Cents (\$0.05) per each One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) of assessed valuation shall be levied pursuant to the provisions of IND. Code § 6-1.1-41-10 and IND. Code § 8-16-3-3 on all taxable property within Clark County to re-establish the *Clark County Cumulative Bridge Fund*.
- 3. Subsequent to approval of the re-establishment of, and tax rate for, the *Clark County Cumulative Bridge Fund* by the DLGF, a property tax rate shall be levied annually at the initially approved rate without necessity of further action by this Board, provided that such tax levy shall be advertised annually in the same manner as other tax levies are advertised, subject only to the provisions of IND. CODE § 6-1.1-41-12.
- 4. The tax established and/or re-established by this Ordinance shall be deposited and held in a special fund to be known as the *Clark County Cumulative Bridge Fund* pursuant to the provisions of IND. CODE § 6-1.1-41-14.
- 5. The *Clark County Cumulative Bridge Fund* may not be expended for any purpose except constructing, maintaining, or repairing bridges, approaches, or grade separations.
- 6. An appropriation may be made from the Clark County Cumulative Bridge Fund without the approval of the DLGF if this Board requests the appropriation for the purpose of constructing, maintaining, or repairing bridges, approaches, or grade separations pursuant to the provisions of IND. CODE § 8-16-3-3(c).
- 7. The Clark County Auditor shall submit a certified copy of this Ordinance to the DLGF promptly after its adoption in accordance with the requirements of IND. Code § 6-1.1-41-

4, notice of which submission shall be published pursuant to the subsequent directions of the DLGF as required by IND. CODE § 6-1.1-41-5.

8. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage and promulgation as evidenced by the affirmative signatures of the undersigned as the majority of the duly elected and serving members of this Board.

## NOTICE TO TAXPAYERS OF HEARING ON THE PROPOSED RE-ESTABLISHMENT OF THE CLARK COUNTY CUMULATIVE BRIDGE FUND

Notice is hereby to the taxpayers of Clark County, Indiana, the Board of Commissioners of Clark County will consider the re-establishment of the Clark County Cumulative Bridge Fund under the provisions of IC 8-16-3, et seq., and IC 6-1.1-41, et seq., for all uses set forth in IC 8-16-3-1, including without limitation, for purposes of constructing, maintaining, or repairing bridges, approaches, or grade separations, during a special meeting commencing at 4:00 o'clock p.m., on Thursday, July 26, 2012, in the Board's Conference Room in the Clark County Government Building, Room 404, 501 E. Court Avenue, Jeffersonville, Indiana.

The tax will be levied on all taxable real and personal property within Clark County and will not exceed Five Cents (\$0.05) per \$100 of assessed valuation. The proposed fund will be levied beginning with the taxes due for 2012 and payable in the year 2013. Taxpayers appearing at such hearing shall have the right to be heard thereon. The proposal for the re-establishment of the Clark County Cumulative Bridge Fund is subject to approval by the Department of Local Government Finance.

Within thirty (30) days after the date of adoption of the re-established Clark County Cumulative Bridge Fund by the Board of Clark County Commissioners, the Clark County Auditor will publish a Notice of Adoption.

Upon publication of the Notice of Adoption, ten (10) or more taxpayers in the taxing district may file a petition with the Clark County Auditor not later than 12:00 o'clock noon thirty (30) days after the publication of the Notice of Adoption setting forth their objections to the proposed levy.
