

RESOLUTION NO. 1-2009

A RESOLUTION REPEALING RESOLUTION NO. 13-2008

WHEREAS, this Board of Commissioners of Clark County, Indiana (this "Board"), is the county executive body pursuant to the provisions of IC 36-2-2-2, and also the county legislative body pursuant to the provisions of IC 36-1-2-9(1); and,

WHEREAS, this Board is authorized to regulate the conduct, use or possession of property that might endanger the public health, safety, or welfare pursuant to the provisions of IC 36-8-2-4; and,

WHEREAS, this Board is further authorized to regulate the introduction of any substance or odor into the air pursuant to the provisions of IC 36-8-2-8; and,

WHEREAS, in the exercise of such authority, this Board adopted Resolution No. 13-2008 entitled *A Resolution Stating Commissioner Policy Concerning Animal Processing Facility* at its regular meeting on December 4, 2008; and,

WHEREAS, this Board in the further exercise of such authority now finds that Resolution No. 13-2008 should be repealed in its entirety.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

1. Clark County Resolution No. 13-2008 entitled *A Resolution Stating Commissioner Policy Concerning Animal Processing Facility* is hereby repealed in its entirety.
2. This Board expressly reserves the authority to subsequently enact additional local legislation regarding the subject matter of the resolution that is repealed herein that in the discretion of this Board may be reasonably necessary to protect the public health and safety of the citizens of Clark County, Indiana.

3. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect upon its passage and promulgation as evidenced by the affirmative signatures of the undersigned as the majority of the duly elected and serving members of this Board.
