Councilperson Doherty offered September 11th, 2023 Regular Council minutes. Councilperson Lenfert motioned to approve the regular meeting minutes of September 11th, 2023 as presented. Councilperson Vissing seconded. Motion approved 6-0.

Councilperson Doherty requested any amendments that need to be made to the agenda. Councilperson Lenfert motioned to approve the agenda as amended. Councilperson Miller seconded. Motion approved 6-0.

Councilperson Miller motioned to acknowledge a receipt of the fund's report provided by the Auditor's office. Councilperson Lenfert seconded the motion. Motion approved 6-0.

Ordinance 30-2023 for Charlestown-Clark County Contractual Library with an adopted tax rate of 0.0453. Motion by Councilperson Lenfert to approve Ordinance 30-2023 for Charlestown-Clark County Contractual Library. Seconded by Councilperson Vissing. Motion approved 6-0.

Jack Coffman with the Clark County Commissioner's presented multiple requests of additional appropriation and one request of a transfer of appropriation. The first additional appropriation request is in the amount of \$5,840.00 for Contract Services in the Enhanced GIS Services fund. The second additional appropriation request is in the amount of \$200,000.00 for Equipment and Equipment Repair in the Local Roads and Streets fund. The last additional

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appropriation request is in the amount of \$1,000,000.00 for C-Town Water Main Expansion in the ARP fund. The final request is a transfer of appropriation in the County General fund in the amount \$31,000.00 from Equipment to General Liability. Motion by Councilperson Lenfert to approve the additional appropriation requests in the Enhanced GIS Services fund, the Local Roads and Streets fund, the ARP fund, and to approve the transfer of appropriation request in the County General fund. Seconded by Councilperson Miller. Motion approved 6-0.

Diane Shahroudi with the Clark County Sheriff presented multiple requests of additional appropriation. The first request is in the amount of \$5,278.90 for Contract Services in the County General fund. The second request is in the amount of \$30,610.00 for Equipment, and \$15,000.00 for Training in the Firearms Training fund. Motion by Councilperson Miller to approve additional appropriation requests in the County General fund, and the Firearms Training fund. Seconded by Councilperson Lenfert. Motion approved 6-0.

Gavan Hebner with Clark County EMA presented a request of additional appropriation. The request is for multiple additional appropriations in the amounts of \$60,000.00 for Equipment, \$82,000.00 for Motor Vehicles, and \$7,000.00 for Training in the 97.067 Hazmat Response fund. Motion by Councilperson Vissing to approve the additional appropriation requests in the 97.067 Hazmat Response fund. Seconded by Councilperson Miller. Motion approved 6-0.

Tonya Shelton with Clark County Youth Coalition presented a request of additional appropriation. The request is for multiple additional appropriations in the amounts of \$12,369.50 for Prevention/Education, \$6,198.25 for Treatment/Intervention, and \$6,198.25 for Law Enforcement/Education in the County Drug Free Community fund. Motion by Councilperson Vissing to approve the additional appropriations in the County Drug Free Community fund. Seconded by Councilperson Miller. Motion approved 6-0.

Councilperson Schiller had pointed out that Councilperson Vissing accidentally grouped two different requests together. Motion by Councilperson Schiller to reconsider the County Drug Free Community fund request. Seconded by Councilperson Lenfert. Motion approved 6-0.

Motion by Councilperson Lenfert to table the request of additional appropriation in the County Drug Free Community fund. Seconded by Councilperson Vissing. Motion approved 6-0.

James Hayden with Clark County Probation asked Tom Lowe to present. Tom Lowe presented multiple requests of additional appropriation. The first request is in the amounts of \$12,415.45 for Personal Services, \$949.78 for FICA/Medicare, and \$1,576.76 for PERF in the County General fund. The final request is in the amounts of \$1,441.69 for Personal Services, \$110.28 for FICA/Medicare, \$183.09 for PERF, and \$20,000.00 for Contract Services in the Alcohol and Drug User Fee fund. Motion by Councilperson Lenfert to approve the additional appropriation requests in the County General fund and in the Alcohol and Drug User Fee fund.

Tom Lowe with the Clark County Courts presented multiple additional appropriation requests and multiple transfer of appropriation requests. The first request is an additional appropriation request in the amounts of \$10,015.02 for Travel, \$5,269.00 for Schools and Conferences, \$720.00 for Dues, \$15,000.00 for Jury Pay, \$15,000.00 for Jury Meals, \$1,132.02 for Travel, and \$236.00 for Schools and Conferences in the County General fund. The second request is a transfer of appropriation request in the amounts of \$448.42 from Travel to Supplies, \$2,000.00 from Furniture and Fixtures to Supplies, and \$1,000.00 from Travel to Supplies in the County General fund. The third request is a request of additional appropriations in the amounts of \$500.00 for Supplies, \$5,000.00 for Training, \$500.00 for Contract Services, and \$1,000.00 for Drug Screening in the Mental Health Problem Solving Court fund. The fourth request is a request of a transfer of appropriations in the Veteran's Court IDOC 1 fund in the amount of \$1,771.29 from Telephone to Supplies (\$1,561.64) and Books & Supplements (\$209.65). The fifth request is an additional appropriation request in the amount of \$10,000.00 for Legal Fees and Charges in the ADR Superior Court fund. The sixth request is an additional appropriation request in the amount of \$5,059.00 for Legal Fees and Charges in the CHINS fund. The seventh request is a request of multiple additional appropriations in the amounts of \$2,000.00 for Display Sign & Ad, \$1,036.72 for Legal Fees and Charges, \$2,000.00 for Training, \$300.00 for Fees, \$245.00 for Computer Software, and \$1,400.00 for Equipment in the Adult Guardianship fund. The eighth request is an additional appropriation request in the amount of \$6,838.97 for Drug Screening in the OVWI Court 10k fund. The ninth and final request is a transfer of appropriation request in the amount of \$832.94 from Drug Screening to Supplies in the OVWI Court 10k fund. Motion by Councilperson Lenfert to approve the additional appropriations in the County General fund; the transfer of appropriation requests in the County General fund; the additional appropriations in the Mental Health Problem Solving Court fund; the transfer of appropriation requests in the Veteran's Court IDOC 1 fund; the additional appropriation in the ADR Superior Court fund; the additional appropriation in the CHINS fund; the additional appropriation in the Adult Guardianship fund; the additional appropriation in the OVWI Court 10k fund; and lastly the transfer of appropriation request in the OVWI Court 10k fund. Seconded by Councilperson Miller. Motion approved 6-0.

Galadriel Ballard with the Clark County Community Corrections presented one additional appropriation request and multiple requests of a transfer of appropriations. The first request is an additional appropriation in the amount of \$5,827.53 for Travel in the Justice Partners Addiction fund. The final request is a transfer of appropriation in the Justice Partners Addiction fund. \$6,900.00 from Personal Services to Contract Services and \$5,000.00 from Personal Services to Travel. Motion by Councilperson Lenfert to approve the additional appropriation request and the transfer of appropriation requests in the Justice Partners Addiction fund. Seconded by Councilperson Abbott. Motion approved 6-0.

Doug Bentfield with the Clark County Health Department presented multiple requests of additional appropriation and one request of a transfer of appropriation. The first request is an

additional appropriation in the amounts of \$36,308.02 for Personal Services, \$2,777.56 for FICA/Medicare, and \$4,611.11 for PERF in the HEALTH fund. The second request is an additional appropriation request in the amount of \$20,000.00 for Equipment in the 93.268 Immunizations Vaccines fund. The third request is an additional appropriation request in the amounts of \$2,500.00 for Contract Services and \$2,500.00 for Utilities in the 93.940 HIV Prevention Project fund. The fourth request is an additional appropriation request in the amounts of \$44,700.00 for Personal Services, \$3,419.55 for FICA/Medicare, \$6,725.05 for Group Insurance, \$5,676.90 for PERF, \$32,174.00 for Motor Vehicle, and \$35,000.00 for Equipment in the VIP FSSA Opioid Community Paramedic fund. The fifth request is an additional appropriation request in the amounts of \$22,811.00 for Personal Services, \$1,889.00 for FICA/Medicare, \$2,500.00 for Supplies, and \$146,000.00 for Housing Assistance in the VIP FSSA Opioid Family Arch fund. The sixth request is an additional appropriation request in the amounts of \$63,820.00 for Personal Services, \$4,820.00 for FICA/Medicare, \$1,800.00 for Vehicle Insurance, \$4,440.00 for Mileage, \$3,623.00 for Computer Hardware/Software, and \$11,000.00 for Motor Vehicle in the VIP FSSA Opioid Thrive fund. The seventh and final request is a transfer of appropriation request in the amount of \$4,000.00 from Equipment to Contract Services in the 93.977 Strengthening Prevention fund. Motion by Councilperson Miller to approve the transfer of appropriation in the 93.977 Strengthening Prevention fund; to approve the additional appropriation requests in the HEALTH fund, the 93.268 Immunizations Vaccines fund, the 93.940 HIV Prevention Project fund, the VIP FSSA Opioid Community Paramedic fund, the VIP FSSA Opioid Family Arch fund, and the VIP FSSA Opioid Thrive fund. Seconded by Councilperson Lenfert. Motion approved 6-0.

Doug Bentfield with the Clark County Health Department presented a Salary Ordinance request. The existing salary is \$44,200.00. The grant was submitted at \$44,700.00. Doug Bentfield stated that he would like to have it start out at \$44,200.00 until the following year based on budget approval. Councilperson Lenfert said that since the new position was not on the 2024 proposed salary ordinance, the Council will have to revise the draft of the salary ordinances in order to include this position. Motion by Councilperson Lenfert to approve the Salary Ordinance request. Seconded by Councilperson Abbott. Motion approved 6-0.

Jack Coffman presented for David Ruckman with the Clark County Surveyor. The request includes one additional appropriation, a transfer of appropriation, and a Salary Ordinance. The first request is additional appropriation in the amount of \$20,000.00 for Contract Services in the Surveyor's Perpetuation fund. The second request is a transfer of appropriation in the amounts of \$20,000.00 from Contract Services to Personal Services (\$17,836.00) and FICA/Medicare. (\$2,164.00) The final request is a Salary Ordinance for a Part-Time position of \$25.00 Per Hour. Motion by Councilperson Lenfert to approve the salary ordinance; the additional appropriation, and the transfer of appropriations in the Surveyor's Perpetuation fund. Seconded by Councilperson Miller. Motion approved 6-0.

Jeremy Mull with the Clark County Prosecutor presented one request of a transfer of appropriation. The request is in the amount of \$2,000.00 from Transcripts and Depositions to Supplies in the County General fund. Motion by Councilperson Lenfert to approve the transfer of appropriation in the County General fund. Seconded by Councilperson Schiller. Motion approved 6-0.

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CLARK COUNTY COUNCIL CONCERNING
ADDITIONAL APPROPRIATIONS
FOR THOSE FUNDS WHICH DO NOT REQUIRE APPROVAL OF THE
DEPARTMENT OF LOCAL GOVERNMENT FINANCE
ORDINANCE NO. 31-2023**

WHEREAS, certain extraordinary conditions have developed since the adoption of the existing annual budget so that it is necessary to appropriate more money than was appropriated in the annual budget.

Section I. BE IT ORDAINED by the Clark County Council of Clark County, Indiana that for expenses of Clark County government and its institutions for the year ending December 31, 2023, the following sums of money are herein specified subject to the law governing the same, such sum herein appropriated shall be held to include all expenditures provided by law.
