REGULAR MEETING

CLARK COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

May 17, 2018

The Board of County Commissioners of Clark County, Indiana met in Regular Session on May 2, 2018, at 5 p.m. in Room 418, Clark County Government Building, Jeffersonville, Indiana.

Present at the meeting were Commissioners – Jack Coffman, Bryan Glover and Connie Sellers, County Attorney Scott Lewis, Commissioners' Assistant Allison Richey and Auditor Monty Snelling. Clark County Engineer Brian Dixon is absent.

Pledge of Allegiance was led by David Lewis and the prayer was led by Jack Coffman.

Approval of the Minutes

Commissioner Sellers made a motion to table May 2, 2018, Regular Meeting Minutes. Commissioner Glover seconded. Motion approved 3-0.

Commissioner Glover motioned to approve the agenda as presented. Commissioner Sellers seconded. Motion approved 3-0.

Clark County Auditor Monty Snelling presented the claims and payroll for May 23, 2018. Commissioner Sellers motioned to approve the claims and payroll. Commissioner Glover seconded. Motion approved 3-3.

I. Administrative Agenda

A. Commissioner Coffman opened the public hearing for a petition to vacate an easement. Ron Culler presented an explanation of this petition. Brian Dixon had some concerns about this easement regarding drainage. He would like something added to the easement concerning how drainage would be handled or possibly information for a culvert for movement of the water. There were no other public comments. Commissioner Glover motioned to table the Vacation of asement petition. Commissioner Sellers seconded. Motion to table approved 3-0.

- **B.** Chelsea Crump, with River Hills, presented grant documents for the Commissioners. Commissioner Glover motioned to approve the Commissioner President to sign the Four-Factor Analysis, Community Development Block Grant Program and the Authorization of Submission for the grant applications. Commissioner Sellers seconded. Motion approved 3-0.
- C. Jerry Acy and David Lewis presented the River Ridge Development Authority Subordinated Tax Increment Revenue Bond Anticipation Note. Commissioner Sellers motioned to approve the River Ridge Development Bond Note. Commissioner Glover seconded. Motion approved 3-0.
- **D.** Commissioner Coffman presented the Covered Bridge Certification indicating that Clark County has no covered bridges. Commissioner Sellers motioned to approve the Covered Bridge Certification. Commissioner Glover seconded. Motion approved 3-0.
- E. Commissioner Coffman presented the open position of Veterans Service office. Joe DeVito, the District Rep for Veterans, is recommending Leslie Curry as the new Veterans Officer. Commissioner Sellers motioned to approve the recommendation to hire Leslie Curry to the position of Veterans Officer. Commissioner Glover seconded. Motion approved 3-0.
- F. Julie Russel & Karen Goodwell presented the proposal to provide Wellness Incentives. This would provide employees a \$40 discount on their insurance premium. Commissioner Sellers motioned to approve the Wellness Incentive program. Commissioner Glover seconded. Motion approved 3-0.
- G. Karen Goodwell next would like to request that the FSA provide a \$500 maximum carry over to the next year to encourage employees to utilize the program. This would be an amendment to the previous BMS agreement.

 Commissioner Glover motioned to approve the FSA maximum carryover of \$500.

 Commissioner Sellers seconded. Motion approved 3-0.

- K. County Attorney Scott Lewis presented an Ordinance to amend Article 9 of Traffic Ordinance to prevent parking in the medians of the County Roads. This is Ordinance No. 12-2018, An Ordinance Amending Ordinance No. 7-1983 (The Clark County Traffic Control Ordinance) Article 9 (Stopping, Standing or Parking Prohibited in Specified Areas). Commissioner Glover motioned to approve Ordinance No. 12. Commissioner Sellers seconded. Motion approved 3-0.
