## Resolution pertaining to the creation of a Cumulative Fire Fund for Charlestown Fire Protection District

This resolution pertains to the Charlestown Fire Protection District of Clark County, Indiana proposal to establish a Cumulative Fire Fund. The purpose of the fund is the purchase of fire equipment and all other legal purposes set forth under IC 36-8-14. Pursuant to IC 36-8-14 the approval of the County Legislative Body (County Commissioners) is required prior to submission to the Department of Local Government Finance for their review.

The proposed establishment of the Cumulative Fire Fund and tax rate has been duly adopted by the Charlestown Fire Protection District Board pursuant to IC 36-8-14. The tax will be levied on all real and personal property within the taxing district and will not exceed three and thirty-three hundredths (0.0333) per \$100 of assessed valuation. The proposed tax rate will be levied beginning with the taxes due and payable in the year of 2019.

Proof of publication of the public hearing held on Wednesday, January 10, 2018, by the Charlestown Fire Protection District, and a certified copy of this resolution are to be submitted to the Department of Local Government Finance of the State of Indiana as provided by law. The tax rate and levy for the Cumulative Fire Fund are subject to the approval of the Department of Local Government Finance.
