BEFORE THE BOARD OF CLARK COUNTY COMMISSIONERS

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS FOR COUNTY CONTRIBUTION TO COUNTY HEALTH INSURANCE COVERAGE COSTS

WHEREAS, this Board of Commissioners of Clark County, Indiana (this "Board"), is the executive body of Clark County government pursuant to the provisions of IC 36-2-2-2; and,

WHEREAS, this Board is also the legislative body of Clark County government pursuant to the provisions of IC 36-1-2-9; and,

WHEREAS, this Board has established a program of group health insurance that is available to its full time employees and other designated beneficiaries, and have established the eligibility and County financial contribution requirements for such eligible beneficiaries; and,

WHEREAS, the County presently faces a significant budgetary crisis that necessitates this Board revising the eligibility requirements for County financial contribution to group health insurance coverage costs as set forth hereinbelow.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by this Board of Clark County Commissioners as follows:

1. For purposes of this Ordinance, "part-time elected officials of Clark County government" shall mean, and be limited to, the elected members of (a) the Board of Clark County Commissioners, and (ii) the Clark County Council.

- Commencing January 1, 2012, part-time elected officials of Clark County 2. government shall remain eligible for enrollment in County group health coverage in the same manner in effect on the date of adoption of this Ordinance.
- 3. Notwithstanding any other provision of this Ordinance, commencing January 1, 2012, part-time elected officials of Clark County government shall not be eligible for County contribution to any County group health insurance coverage in which such official elects to participate.
- 4. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage and promulgation as evidenced by the affirmative signatures of the undersigned as the majority of the duly elected and serving members of this Board.
