ORDINANCE NO. _2013

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING NON-REVERTING FUND NUMBER 4961 – "CONSOLIDATED E911 INITIAL OUTLAYS"

WHEREAS, this Board of Commissioners of Clark County, Indiana (this "Board"), is the executive body of Clark County government pursuant to the provisions of I.C. 36-2-2-2; and,

WHEREAS, this Board is also the legislative body of Clark County government pursuant to the provisions of I.C. 36-1-2-9; and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to Home Rule provisions of IC 36-1-3, *et seq.*, this Board has the authority to exercise all the powers needed for the effective operation of government as to local affairs, subject only to the limitations contained within statutes; and,

WHEREAS, this Board has identified the need to establish a fund for the consolidated E911 to allow them the ability to operate proficiently.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by this Board of Clark County Commissioners as follows:

- 1. The establishment of Fund Number 4961 "Consolidated E911 Initial Outlays" (non-reverting).
- 2. The monies shall be expended for, but not limited to: operating expenses; personnel salaries; benefits; building maintenance; equipment; training expenses; travel; and professional services for the consolidated E911.
- 3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage and promulgation as evidenced by the affirmative signatures of the undersigned as the majority of the duly elected and serving members of this Board.
