

**Minutes of the Meeting
of the Clark County Drainage Board
Clark County, Indiana**

October 17, 2017

The Clark County Drainage Board met in Regular Session on October 17, 2017 in Room 418 of the Clark County Government Building, Jeffersonville, Indiana at 5:00pm. Present at the meeting were President Mike Killen, Vice President Jack Coffman, Member Les Kavanaugh, Ex-officio non-voting member Clark County Surveyor David Blankenbeker, and secretary Talaina Taff. Non-voting advisor Clark County Engineer Brian Dixon was absent. Attorney Bob Bottorff was absent; Attorney David Nachand served as his substitute.

For the first order of business, Mr. Kavanaugh moved to accept the minutes of the September 19, 2017 meeting as submitted. Mr. Coffman seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

In the next order of business, the Board conducted a continuation of the hearing from May 16, 2017 on the obstruction of a natural surface water course.

Mr. Coffman moved to approve the plans contingent upon changing the name of the subdivision on the final plat and also Mr. Brian Dixon's final review of the plans. Mr. Kavanaugh seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

In the next order of business, **Mr. Chad McCormick** presented plans for Champions Pointe Section 8 (aka Champions Commons). Mr. Kavanaugh moved to approve the plans contingent upon Mr. Brian Dixon reviewing the plans. Mr. Coffman seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

In the next order of business, Ms. Taff presented the budget report. Mr. Kavanaugh moved to accept the report as presented. Mr. Coffman seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

In the next order of business, Mr. Coffman moved to approve the claims as submitted. Mr. Kavanaugh seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously. The claims were as follows:


