The Gathering Spot

Located in the central plaza of historic Rose Island, the fountain was a natural meeting place for families enjoying a day on the island. Friends would gather to plan their activities—should they ride the roller coaster, rent a row boat or play baseball?



Still Standing

Built of mortared limestone, the water once bubbled up through the center of the fountain and cascaded down the sides. Though much of the fountain has collapsed, a portion of the original fountain still stands today.

Did You Know?

Water for the fountain was pumped from an aquifer located 200 feet below where you stand.
