RESOLUTION OF THE
CLARK COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS, INDIANA
AUTHORIZING THE APPROVAL OF THE CHILDPLACE SPECIALIZED CARE UNIT
FEASIBILITY STUDY PLANNING GRANT REPORT
TO THE INDIANA OFFICE OF COMMUNITY AND RURAL AFFAIRS
AND ADDRESSING RELATED MATTERS

WHEREAS, the Clark County Board of Commissioners recognizes the need to stimulate growth and to maintain a sound economy within its corporate limits; and


WHEREAS, the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as amended, authorizes the Indiana Office of Community and Rural Affairs to provide grants to local units of government to meet the housing and community development needs of low and moderate income persons; and


WHEREAS, the Clark County Board of Commissioners, Clark County, Indiana, has conducted or will conduct public hearings prior to the submission of the final report to the Indiana Office of Community and Rural Affairs, said public hearings to assess the housing, public facilities and economic needs of its low and moderate income residents;

The Clark County Commissioners authorize the approval of the Childplace Specialized Care Unit Feasibility Study contingent on the final approval by the Indiana Office of Community and Rural Affairs.
