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MINUTES OF REGULAR BOARD MEETING OF THE CLARK COUNTY RECYCLING DISTRICT JUNE 24, 2026

Call to Order:

The Meeting of the Clark County Recycling District was called to order by Board President Jennifer Voignier, at 5:00 p.m., held in the Meeting Room #103, Clark County Government Center, 300 Corporate Dr., Jeffersonville, Indiana, on June 24, 2026.

Roll Call:

Roll call was conducted: The following CCRD Board Members were present: Jennifer Voignier, Steve Doherty, David Decker, Bryan Glover, and Jack Coffman. Board Members Mike Moore and Scott Anderson were not present. Board Controller, Jeff Cox, Board Attorney, Jake Elder, Director, Debby McGrath, and Board Secretary, Darla Stahl, were also present.

Approval of Minutes:

Board member Bryan Glover made a motion to approve the CCRD Minutes from May 27, 2026, with Jack Coffman seconding the motion. Motion carried 5-0.

Old Business:

GreenLine Solutions Fuel Surcharge: Marcus Renn addressed the cost of fuel remains high and requested a fuel surcharge continuance for the next quarter. Jack Coffman made a motion to continue the fuel surcharge extension (\$500 monthly) for the third quarter of 2026 with David Decker seconding the motion. Motion carried 5-0.

Controller Report:

Jeff Cox discussed the June claims. Motion to approve the June 2026, claims in the amount of \$147,966.72 made by Steve Doherty with Bryan Glover seconding the motion. Motion carried 5-0.

Mr. Cox also reviewed CCRD budget status. Discussion to continue.

Executive Director Report

Multifamily Recycling: Debby McGrath reviewed responses received to date to March 25, 2026 letter. After discussion it was decided to send a certified letter with return receipt to facilities who have not yet responded as of this date. Reminder letter to be sent by July 15 following with a postcard and email notifications to properties.

IDEM Tire Grant: \$10,000 grant contract finalized, and project is underway.

IDEM CRGP Grant: First round of 96 gal. containers received and distributed to curbside residents. Second set of 364 containers is to be delivered in mid-July.

May Monthly Recycling Totals: Curbside 109.08 tons. Unincorporated areas: Borden 6.85 tons, Charlestown 41.14 tons, Henryville 7.8 tons, Memphis 5.39 tons, New Washington 4.17 tons, Starlight 7.95 tons.

Total May Recycling Collection: 192.38 tons

May Charlestown Traffic Count: 2,893 (average of 137 cars daily Mon.-Fri.)
