

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING
LOCAL COURT CHANGE FUND NO. 2

ORDINANCE NO. 6 - 2006

WHEREAS, the Clark Superior Court No. 2 ("Court" or "the Court") is located in the City-County Building in Jeffersonville, Clark County, Indiana and operates and supervises probation services and functions relating to persons convicted of crimes;

WHEREAS, a need exists to, in order to assist that supervision function, to establish a local court change fund No. 2 that will accommodate persons on probation who desire to pay certain fees and who may need change from currency presented, from time-to-time, for payment of those fees;

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Clark County ("Board") is the County legislative body pursuant to I.C. 36-1-2-9(1) and is authorized to enact Ordinances for the establishment of local funds;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board as follows:

- (1) There is hereby established the "Court Local Change Fund No. 2" (the "change fund") by virtue of this Ordinance;
- (2) The balance in the fund, after enactment of this Ordinance shall not exceed One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) at any given time during the life of the fund, unless this Ordinance is amended to change this balance amount;
- (3) The purpose of the fund shall be to enable staff members of the Court to make change when currency is presented, for payment of fees by persons on probation through the Court from time-to-time;
- (4) Expenditures from the fund shall be made solely for the above purposes;
- (5) The fund shall be identified on official County records as "Court Local Change Fund No. 2";
- (6) The Court is requested to keep accurate records of cash used in the Court Local Change Fund No. 2, and to make those records available to the Auditor of Clark County from time-to-time so that the Auditor may be in a position to make, or complete, any State-required reports required by law;

(7) The establishment of this local fund is effective on the date shown below:
