Pursuant to IC 36-8-14-2 (d) Monroe Township Fire Protection District must receive the approval of the Clark County Commissioners prior to establishment of a proposed Cumulative Fire Fighting Fund

Ordinance/Resolution Pertaining to Monroe Township Fire Protection District Cumulative Fire Fund

This Ordinance/Resolution pertains to the Monroe Township Fire Protection District Board of Clark County, Indiana, proposal to establish a Cumulative Fire Fund Fund. The purpose of the Fund is the purchase of fire equipment and all other legal purposes set forth under IC 36-8-14. Pursuant to Indiana Code 36-8-14 the approval of the County Legislative Body (County Commissioners) is required prior to submission to the Department of Local Government Finance for their review.

The proposed establishment of the Cumulative Fire Fund and tax rate has been duly adopted by the Monroe Township Fire Protection District Board pursuant to Indiana Code 36-8-14. The tax will be levied on all real and personal property within the taxing district and will not exceed three and thirty-three one hundredths (0.0333) per \$100 of assessed valuation. The proposed tax rate will be levied beginning with the taxes due and payable in the year of 2018.

Proofs of publication of the public hearing held on Monday, April 3, 2017, by the Monroe Township Fire Protection District, and a certified copy of this resolution are to be submitted to the Department of Local Government Finance of the State of Indiana as provided by law. The tax rate and levy for the Cumulative Fire Fund is subject to the approval of the Department of Local Government Finance.
