RESOLUTION NO. 21-2016

A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT FOR THE SALE OF ROAD SALT AND/OR BRINE SOLUTION TO THE GREATER CLARK COUNTY SCHOOL CORPORATION.

WHEREAS, this Board of Commissioners of Clark County, Indiana (this “Board”), is the executive body of Clark County government pursuant to the provisions of I.C. 36-2-2-2; and

WHEREAS, this Board is also the legislative body of Clark County government pursuant to the provisions of I.C. 36-1-2-9; and,

WHEREAS, I.C. 36-1-7 allows political subdivisions in the State of Indiana to enter into Interlocal Agreements; and,

WHEREAS, it is the desire and intent of this Board to enter into the Interlocal Agreement with the Greater Clark County School Corporation (“GCCS”), an Indiana government entity, for the sale of road salt/and or brine solution made by the Clark County Highway Department for use in clearing the parking lots of GCCS owned properties in the Charlestown and New Washington areas by using the County’s brine machine during times of inclement weather.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by this Board of Clark County Commissioners as follows:

1. The Board hereby approves the Interlocal Agreement with GCCS attached hereto as Exhibit “A” on the terms and conditions set forth therein.

2. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect upon its passage and promulgation as evidenced by the affirmative signatures of the undersigned as the majority of the duly elected and serving members of this Board.




